Civil services refers to a group of services who are responsible for the administration of the country. They form policies at the higher level and execute them in the field. The services include IAS, IPS, IRS etc.

Union Public Services commission conducts examination annually to select candidates for these services.

Structure of Examinations

The exam has three stages:

- 1 **Preliminary (Objective)**: Tests general knowledge and aptitude.
- 2 **Main (Subjective)**: Tests in-depth knowledge of subjects.
- 3 **Personality Test (Interview)**: Assesses personality, communication skills, and leadership abilities.

Attempts/Age

- Age Limit: 21-32 years (relaxable for SC/ST/OBC)
- Attempts: General-6, OBC-9, SC/ST-Unlimited (until age limit)

Weekly Schedule

- 1 General Studies (GS) for Prelims**
 - 6 hours per week, spread across various topics based on the detailed subject breakdown above.
- 2 CSAT (Civil Services Aptitude Test)**
 - 1 session per week, 2 hours.
